We have several operational updates due to the decision to delay move-in for residential students to September 3-6. All undergraduate courses will begin online on August 25.

Room & Board Adjustments

EMU will be adjusting room & board charges on a prorated basis due to the two-week delay in opening campus to residential students. Adjustments will post to student accounts by Friday, August 28.

Textbooks

We realize many students have textbooks in the Campus Center mail room that are needed for classes. We will forward books to students by request. Please send an email requesting forwarding service to: mailroom@emu.edu.

The EMU Bookstore is directly contacting students who placed an online order for store pickup, and will arrange shipment.

We understand that some students were waiting to purchase textbooks until arrival on campus. Please begin the process of purchasing necessary textbooks with attention to the shipment arrival date and your location, and inform your professors of your situation during the first days of class.
