PROGRAM DETAILS

The LOM with the aviation concentration is comprised of 120 credits.

- EMU at Lancaster collaborates with Aero-Tech Services, Inc., an FAA-approved Part 141 pilot school, to provide pilot training. Flight training will occur at the Aero-Tech facility at Lancaster Airport in Lititz, Pennsylvania.
- All aviation and leadership courses are in person.
- Students will earn their Private, Instrument, Commercial (with multi-engine rating), and Flight Instructor Certificates.
- ▶ 15 week aviation internship built into the program.

- The graduates of our Collegiate Aviation program are qualified to train and test for the Airline Transport Certificate at 1000 hours of flight time.
- Private Pilot Certificate may transfer to our program.
- Access to regional airline cadet and pilot prep programs.
