



CHURCH SPONSORSHIP GRANT PROGRAM – Graduate Programs 2024-2025 Commitment Form

Qualifying students may receive grants or scholarships from a congregation, a church conference, or a group of churches as ecclesial bodies who have budgeted or pooled resources for the purpose of providing tuition assistance. The Seminary graduate program offers substantial tuition scholarships up to 100% and so does not make additional matching grants while the Center for Justice and Peacebuilding and Master of Arts in Counseling graduate programs offer matching grants based on ecclesial contributions. To contribute to a graduate student’s tuition and fees, this form should be completed and signed by an appropriate church official and returned by March 1, 2024 or as soon as possible!

Seminary students* – are eligible to receive ecclesial contributions to tuition and fees, regardless of degree program or full-time status.

Graduate students (CJP and MAC programs only) - must be admitted, degree-seeking, and enrolled at least half-time (5 or more credits per term.) Master’s degree students may receive annual matching grants (dollar for dollar) of \$1000 per award year (\$2000 career maximum), certificate students (\$1000 career maximum).

Note: The total sum of a church grant received and the matching grant awarded from EMU may not exceed the tuition and fee charges for the awarded term. Also, the total seminary aid awarded for a given term may not exceed the tuition for that term.

**Degree –seeking seminary students admitted prior to 2024 may receive a matching grant from EMS as outlined in their admission letter and based on their course load. Half-time students (5-8 credits/semester) may receive annual matching grants (dollar for dollar) of \$1000 per award year which includes fall, spring and summer terms. Full-time students (9 or more credits/semester) may receive a matching grant (dollar for dollar) of \$2000 per award year (includes fall, spring and summer terms) and an additional 1:4 match for any amount over \$2000.*
