

Identification Requirements for Civilian Candidates

PRIMARY ID must be a government-issued photo ID. The ID must include the candidate's name, signature, and a recognizable photograph.

Acceptable forms of **primary identification** include:

- Current passport with name, photograph, and signature
- Valid driver's license with name, photograph, and signature
- State or Providence ID issued by the motor vehicle agency with name, photograph, and signature
- Military ID
- National ID with name, photograph, and signature
- A tribal ID card
- A naturalization card or certificate of citizenship
- If the student is a minor and unable to provide a primary government-issued ID, then the **College Board ID Form** may be used for primary ID. This form must include a recognizable photo, and the school seal must overlap the photo.

The student must sign the ID form in the presence of the student's counselor or principal. The student will be asked to sign the ID form again at the test center. The form is valid only in United States test centers. It must be dated and is good for only one year.

The SECONDARY ID must contain *either a photo or a signature*. Acceptable forms of **secondary identification** include:

- A current student ID
- A military ID (Common Assess Card)
- An unused ID from the primary choices above

Unacceptable ID Documents

- Credit or debit cards of any kind
- Social Security card
- Employee ID
