

Common Grounds Coffee House Finance Manager Job Description

The Finance Manager oversees overall finances and budgetary aspects of Common Grounds. This is a leadership position ideal for a student interested in a professional career in small business finances and accounting. Strengths and skills should include: money handling, math/computation, Excel spreadsheets, an interest in further developing current accounting and reporting systems, being detail-oriented, being dependable and thorough. This is a non-work study position available to current students at EMU. Position reports to Common Grounds Staff Coordinator.

Specific Duties:

- 1. Manage the budget, including regular deposits, cash drawer handling, billing, invoicing and regular oversight of the budget online
- 2. Send and track invoices to groups and departments
- 3. Process gift cards ordered and purchased in the shop
- 4. Analyze sales data and create necessary financial documents and reports suitable for reporting to the managers
- 5. Train barista staff to properly utilize the Point of Sale system (POS)
- 6. Maintain POS and address any issues as they arise
- 7. Work with Products Manager to maintain a functioning cost analysis system and set product prices

General Duties:

- 1. Work 8-10 hours a week during the school year. Additional work before the beginning of each semester and over breaks may be necessary.
- 2. Convene a weekly team meeting with assigned barista group
- 3. Attend weekly meetings with other Common Grounds Managers
- 4. Attend a weekly 1 on 1 with the Staff Supervisor
- 5. Follow, update and maintain a job manual specific to the position

Preferred:

- The prefered candidate will have taken the following courses at EMU:
 - o Financial Accounting
 - Managerial Accounting
 - o Intermediate Accounting I & II, and MIS: relates the most closely with POS

Practicum Opportunity:

Business department students would be eligible for a 3 credit business internship, and non-department students would be eligible for a 1 credit Leadership practicum.
