Once enrolled at EMU, students will follow the LOM program of study. Students enroll in a blended format program lasting four semesters. Courses are arranged in a predetermined curriculum for the student to follow with his/her cohort. Courses (five weeks in length) are completed one-at-a-time in sequential order. LOM 460 is completed concurrent with other coursework.
