ADVISING NOTES

The Traditional Clinical Nursing (BSN) degree is not a direct admit program. Students must first be admitted to the university before applying to the Clinical Program.

Admission Requirements:

- ▶ Completion of 60 semesters hours of college credit at time of enrollment in level one
- ▶ Cumulative 2.8 GPA at the time of application
- ▶ Kaplan Admission Test
- ▶ Specific pre-requisite nursing courses must be passed with a C or higher
- ▶ No more than two pre-requisite courses may be repeated
- ▶ A single pre-requisite may not be repeated more than once
- ▶ Prerequisite courses must have been completed in the past 10 years

Application Process and Materials:

- ▶ Submit University Transfer Application
- ▶ Request official high school transcript
- ▶ Request official college transcript(s) from each college/university attended.
- ▶ Submit Clinical Nursing Application
 - Application deadlines for the fall semester is **February 15** with final decision of admissions by March 30.
 - Application deadlines for the spring semester is **June 15** with final decision of admissions by July 30.

Admission to the clinical nursing program is competitive with 24 admitted students during each fall and spring semesters. Students who transfer before completing the transfer degree may complete their remaining general education requirements/pre-requisite courses at EMU while waiting to begin the nursing program. Students who elect to do this, should meet with an EMU transfer counselor.
