

Billing and Payment plans

Statements:

Paper statements will be mailed 08/01/2015 to students who are registered for fall 2015 courses. We are still having issues with the electronic statement, but our goal is have it available by mid-August. Paper statements will be issued the next several months regardless of status of ebill to help with the transition from paper to ebill.

CASHNet:

CASHNet is the new method for accessing your EMU account online. Students are introduced to CASHNet with a bright sticker on the statement. Students login into my.emu.edu / accounts / CASHNet My Account Info / in box to right of screen. Payment through CASHNet is the preferred method of payment. There is no fee for paying with checking account, and a 2.75% fee for using a credit or debit card. Payment methods can be saved and used again next semester! Each faculty / staff person has an account, I encourage you to visit the site and let me know what you think!

Payment Plans:

Anyone with charges in FA2015 can participate in the payment plan. Payment plans are accessed on the student page on CASHNet.

- ~\$35.00 enrollment fee (plans are for one semester at a time)
- ~Only one payment plan option: 4 payments: Aug, Sept, Oct & Nov.
- ~Contract total calculates automatically using the account balance on EX. Contract will auto adjust as additional charges and credits happen on the account. ☺
- ~Cannot set up payment plan until charges for FA2015 are on the account.
- ~Monthly payment plan payments are due the 15th of each month with a late fee after 10 days.
- ~Last day to enroll in payment plan, September 30

****Seminary and CJP Only** Gallagher Student Health Insurance:**

All traditional Undergraduate students taking 12 or more credit hours, all International students, full-time Seminary and full-time CJP students are automatically enrolled in and billed for student health insurance. If the student is currently insured by a plan that provides comparable coverage, the student can waive enrollment by completing a waiver at www.gallagherstudent.com/emu and the charge will be removed from the account within one business day.

NOTE: If a student signs up for a monthly payment plan, then declines the health insurance, the contract will be adjusted when the charge is removed from the student account. Our goal is to remove the insurance charge daily upon completion of the waiver. The first payment may be larger than anticipated until the insurance charge is removed.
