

EMU is pleased to provide students with the opportunity to live in an apartment complex adjacent to campus. The three-building complex is located on Mt. Clinton Pike (see map on back), and includes 12 one-bedroom apartments.

Village Apartments offer housing for married and older single students in a community setting that is convenient to campus.

Residency Requirements

Residents of the EMU-owned Village
Apartments must be a student at EMU,
maintain a 2.0 GPA and have no major
disciplinary incidents on their record. In the
case of a married couple, one spouse must be a
student. A maximum of two persons can live in
an apartment. Additionally, students must have
met one of the following criteria:

- Earned at least 90 semester hours of credit by September 1 of the academic year in which off-campus housing is requested. (i.e., senior status) AND be at least 21 years of age by September 1 of the academic year in which off-campus housing is requested.
- 2. Be at least 24 years of age by September 1 of the academic year in which off-campus housing is requested, regardless of credit hours earned.

Apartment Features

- · Immediate access to campus
- Two floors
- One bedroom, living/dining area, kitchen, full bath
- · Major kitchen appliances
- Furnished
- Wall air-conditioning unit in bedroom
- Laundry facilities within the three-building complex

Cost

Rent/Billing

The monthly rent is \$560 with a rental period of 10-12 months. Monthly rent for 8-9 month rental is \$590. Monthly rent for a rental period less than 8 months is \$610.

NOTE: Rates in effect July 1 - June 30.

A rental account is established for each individual in the apartment and is charged based upon the length of the lease.

Utilities

EMU covers wireless internet, water, sewer and trash pickup. Tenant covers electricity (which is set up in EMU's name and billed to rental account), phone, and cable as needed.

Deposit

Security deposit is \$500. It includes:

- \$250 is required with the attached reservation form to secure the apartment
- \$250 balance due when the lease is signed
- \$350 of the deposit is refundable at the end of the lease, within 30 days, provided the apartment was well-maintained and all agreements met
