

EMU Payment Info

Billing -

- We will be sending out the first Statement for Fall 2025 at the beginning of July. The email notification for this statement will be sent to the student's EMU email.
- Tuition account, less processed financial aid, is due August 19th (one week before classes start).
- Students can view their bill through their EMU account online by logging into their my.emu.edu and clicking on the 'View my EMU Account Online' button under the accounts tab.
- **Students must grant online account access for their parent/guardian** by setting up an authorized user account through their EMU account online. Step by step instructions can be found on the Business Office questions page linked in the chat. This also acts as a FERPA release for the Business Office for the authorized parent/guardian allowing us to discuss financial information about your EMU tuition account.
- Please note that if you have not registered for classes with an advisor the July bill will not be complete as it will not include course fees or program fees. Please register for an advising session as listed in the first step of your "Enrollment Checklist."
- If you are a Nursing or Engineering major an additional program fee of \$500 per semester will be applied to your tuition statement each semester. This fee is in lieu of Nursing and Engineering course fees and covers the labs and materials specific for the major.

Payment Plan –

- A five Month Payment Plan is available through the student's EMU account online.
- The **first payment is due upon enrollment plus a \$35 enrollment fee**. You can enroll in the 5-month Fall plan through **July 14th**. The payment plan will become available once the Fall statement has been generated.
- The remaining 4 payments will be due by the 15th of August, September, October, and November. You can sign up for autopayment after you have completed enrollment.

Health Insurance

- Health insurance is required for all full-time students. The offered policy is through United Healthcare at an estimated amount of \$3,166.00 for the year (coverage from August 1, 2025 to July 31, 2026).
- A **Pending** insurance charge will show on the July statement; students will need to either enroll in or decline/waive the insurance.
- If a **student needs the offered health insurance** they will need to **enroll** (available starting in June).
- If a **student already has comparable insurance** they will need to **decline/waive** the offered Insurance (available now!).
- Comparable coverage - The level of benefits should meet or exceed the benefits provided through the Student Health Insurance Plan. Coverage is considered comparable if it provides students with access to a range of services in and around the area where they attend school.
 - Plans that only provide emergency services in the campus area are not considered comparable.
