

Billing

- The first Fall 2026 statement will be issued in **early July**. Email notifications will be sent to students' EMU email accounts.
- Tuition balances, minus processed financial aid, are **due August 25th** (one week before classes begin).
- Students can view their bill by logging into **my.emu.edu** and selecting "View My EMU Account Online" under the Accounts tab.
- **Students must grant online account access for their parent/guardian!** Instructions are available on the Business Office Questions page linked in the chat. Authorized payer access also serves as a FERPA release, allowing the Business Office to discuss financial information with that parent/guardian.
- If you have not registered for classes with an advisor, your July statement will not include course or program fees. Please schedule an advising session as outlined in Step 1 of your Enrollment Checklist.
- Nursing and Engineering majors are charged a **\$510 program fee** each semester. This fee replaces course fees and covers major-specific labs and materials.

Payment Plan

- A **5-Month Payment Plan** is available through the student's EMU account online.
- **Enrollment requires the first payment plus a \$35 enrollment fee.** The Fall payment plan will be available after Fall statements are issued, and enrollment is open through **July 14**.
- The remaining payments are due on **August 15, September 15, October 15, and November 15**. Autopay can be set up after enrollment.
- The Spring payment plan will be available in December.

Health Insurance & Athletic Insurance

- Health insurance is **required for all full-time students**. EMU's student health insurance plan through United Healthcare is estimated at **\$3,266** for the year (August 1, 2026 – July 31, 2027).
- A **pending** insurance charge will appear on the July statement. Students must either enroll in or waive/decline the insurance coverage.
- Students needing the EMU plan may enroll beginning in June.
- Students with comparable coverage must submit a waiver (available soon).
- An email will be sent to students once insurance enrollment and waiver forms are available.
- **Comparable coverage must provide benefits that meet or exceed the student health insurance plan** and include access to healthcare services in the area where the student attends school. Plans that only cover emergency services near campus do not qualify.
- All student-athletes are required to carry **EMU's athletic secondary insurance coverage**. Additional information will be provided by Athletics, and the charge will appear on the August statement.
