

Update on COVID-19 Preparedness at EMU at Lancaster

Dear EMU at Lancaster campus community,

As the COVID-19 (coronavirus) situation continues to evolve we know there are likely many questions. EMU is taking all necessary steps to protect the health and well-being of our students, faculty, and staff.

Currently there are 13 presumptive positive cases and only 2 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Pennsylvania. There are no reported cases in the EMU@Lancaster community or in Lancaster County. At this time, while we are monitoring the situation and taking prudent steps to minimize risk. We are open for business as usual, continuing to hold classes and operating according to our normal schedules and policies.

Custodial Services at the Lancaster site have increased attention to disinfecting public areas and especially commonly touched surfaces **after every class**. We are closely monitoring updates and recommendations from the <u>Centers for Disease Control (CDC)</u> and the <u>Pennsylvania Department of Health</u>.
