Sustainable Together - imagining a campus within the climate crisis



Office of DEI's Sustainability Team in collaboration with Creation Care Council, SFI, and Earthkeepers hosted a 1 ½-hour small group discussion with 30 students, faculty, and staff around sustainability at EMU.





We dove into thought-provoking questions such as the intersections of climate change and justice and the responsibilities we hold as a university and campus community in fostering environmental action. Students sparked conversation about how to cultivate a culture of sustainability through empowerment, education, and collaboration/active participation.



In collaboration with the Department of Biology during Earth Day weekend, 40 students, faculty, staff, and community members volunteered to removing invasive species in Park Woods, and hung out with goats that are a part of the invasive removal process. Prof. Jim Yoder heads the project funding with Advancement to raise awareness and community involvement in this urban wood space on EMU's campus.
