| o Virginia residents enrolling full-time, complete the 2026-27 VA Tuition Assistance Grant application. VTAG application available at emu.edu/vtag . | as soon as possible |
| <i>Submit completed application to EMU. Deadline: July 31, 2026!</i>
<i>NOTE: VTAG application is not needed from returning students who received VTAG in prior academic year.</i> | |
| o Review your 2026-27 EMU Financial Aid Notification when received by email; accept/decline aid online and complete any requested documents. | within 30 days |
| <i>A financial aid notification is generated after a student has been admitted and submitted both the FAIS and FAFSA.</i> | |
