as soon as possible

o Complete the 2025-26 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at fafsa.gov; EMU code is 003708.

April 15

Must be enrolled at least half-time (5 credits per term) for federal student loan eligibility. The FAFSA is required if applying for federal student loans; however, the FAFSA is not a student loan application.

o Review your 2025-26 EMU Financial Aid Notification when received by email; accept/decline aid online and complete any needed requested documents.

within 30 days

A financial aid notification is generated after a student has been admitted and submitted both the FAIS and FAFSA.
