POSITION: Fulltime, tenure track, computer/electrical engineer faculty position (Assistant or Associate Professor)

QUALIFICATIONS: Ph.D. in computer engineering or Ph.D. in electrical engineering or other related field with experience in computer engineering. Teaching experience preferred. Evidence of scholarship in the field that can involve undergraduate students and ability to contribute to university and departmental service.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Teach courses in computer engineering (Digital Circuits, Analog Circuits, Architecture and Operating Systems, Engineering Design course, upper-level CE topics course), advise students, recruit students, supervise student projects, conduct research, and perform university service. Applicants must have a strong commitment to high quality teaching and serving a community of diverse learners.

POSITION DETAILS: Nine-month contract, 24 semester hours per year. EMU uses a tenure-with-review contract system.
