- QUALIFICATIONS:** Master's degree in music required; evidence of successful wind and/or brass directing experience strongly preferred; and Christian faith with a strong connection to the values espoused by EMU that draw from its Anabaptist/Mennonite heritage.
- RESPONSIBILITIES:** Responsibilities for this position include directing the EMU Wind Ensemble, EMU Jazz Band, and EMU Pep Band. The Director of Bands will also work with music faculty on recruitment, concert scheduling, and also attend department meetings. Additional teaching opportunities are possible based on department needs, and the successful candidate's areas of expertise.
