POSITION: Engineering Lab technician/manager

QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelors in engineering or related field (preferably mechanical, electrical, or computer engineering). Bachelor's degree may be substituted for four years related experience.

1. Previous experience in engineering laboratories, including equipment operation and basic maintenance, is desired.
2. Knowledge of safety practices and precautions applicable to engineering laboratories is required.
3. Basic computer skills are required.
4. Lifting of some heavy objects; standing and/or walking for extended periods of time.
5. Some leadership or management experience preferred.
6. Certification by certifying bodies such as NICET, WACEL is a plus.

RESPONSIBILITIES: The engineering laboratory technician assures the efficient operation of the engineering academic laboratories and ensures that lab safety rules are fully implemented. General duties of the lab technician are to oversee technical work in the engineering laboratories, which include the preparation of materials and equipment; maintenance of machinery and equipment; recordkeeping; and assistance with faculty and students projects.
