



ANNOUNCEMENT OF Social Work Professor Recruitment

Department of Applied Social Sciences

POSITION: Full-time Assistant or Associate Professor in a tenure-track faculty position for Social Work.

QUALIFICATIONS: MSW degree and a minimum of two years practice experience is required. Preferred candidates will possess a Ph.D. degree in Social Work, or be ABD, OR possess an MSW degree with advanced practice experience, licensure in social work, and/or previous college teaching experience in the discipline.

Cross-cultural (international) experience is desirable; a strong affinity for the values espoused by EMU that draw from its Anabaptist/Mennonite heritage; desire and ability to engage diverse students.

POSITION DETAIL & RESPONSIBILITIES:

Eastern Mennonite University's BSW program, located at Harrisonburg in Virginia's scenic Shenandoah Valley, has been continuously accredited by the Council on Social Work Education [CSWE] since 1976. We are a distinctive social work program in a historically faith-based institution where values of community, service, and peacebuilding are practiced.

The CSWE Educational Policy and Accreditation Standards provide a foundation for the program's curriculum and assessment of student learning outcomes. The program is additionally grounded in an implicit curriculum provided by a vibrant University, renown for its peace and justice emphases, which draw diverse people from all over the world for study. The University's CORE education requirements emphasize the importance of diversity, inter-faith dialogue, and cross-cultural understanding. Every undergraduate student must fulfill cross-cultural requirements through structured group experiences; most travel for a semester in other countries. The campus community encourages caring relationships, deep spiritual exploration, and a global perspective.

This is an opportunity to join this learning community and make collaborative contributions teaching from your base of scholarship and/or practice background. The position will carry both teaching and field responsibilities (typically with three courses per semester with additional field assignments). Applicants must have a strong commitment to high-quality teaching and be enthusiastic about mentoring and advising students. Engagement in ongoing scholarly activity and departmental service is expected.

COMPENSATION: Nine-month contract. Salary determined by education and experience. Eastern Mennonite University uses a tenure-with-review contract system.

APPOINTMENT DATE: Position begins mid-August 2020. EMU reserves the right to fill the position at any time or keep the position open.
