

## **Information About International Applications**

The first step is to fill out an online application form at [emu.edu/iep](http://emu.edu/iep)

You will need at least **\$29,940 USD in the bank to cover:**

Tuition: \$14,990 (2 semesters)

Living Expenses: \$12,600 (EMU dorm)

Or \$8000 or \$5000 depending on your living situation

Health Insurance \$2,300

TOTAL: \$29,940 in the bank account, retirement account or investment account (You do not pay this all at one time, but must show that it is in the bank before you can get a visa.)

You can show bank accounts from family or friends who want to give you money. It can be more than one person.

**Documents** you will need:

1. **Financial Certification Form** (attached)
2. **Bank Statements** from the last 90 days that support the amount indicated on the Financial Certification Form (at least \$29,940 USD)
3. **Letter of Financial Sponsorship** (if funds are not in your name) instructions attached
4. **Letter of recommendation:** teacher, employer, religious leader (non-family member)
5. **Official transcripts** of the most recent study (in English)
6. **Photocopy of passport**

**You pay:**

1. Deposit \$250 to EMU before you get the I-20 (paper needed for visa)
2. SEVIS fee \$350 (US government)
3. The visa fee is about \$150 depending on the embassy
4. AFTER you get the visa, then you pay the remaining \$7,245 before coming to the U.S. for one semester. Then you make payments after that.
5. Be sure to get travel health insurance before your trip.
