

# Transfer from DSLCC to EMU at Lancaster for seamless transition to the RN to BS in Nursing program.



- All 67-68 credits of the DSLCC ADN transfer to EMU at Lancaster
- EMU requires eight (8) gen eds as part of the 120-credit bachelor's degree - six (6) of these are already built into the DSLCC ADN program of study!

## HOW DO YOU ACHIEVE THE 120 CREDITS FOR THE BS IN NURSING?

- 67 ADN credits transferred + 43 credits of EMU nursing courses + 3 credits of statistics + 2 credits of speech + 3 credits of history or literature = 118
- Add 2 additional hours of any other credit from accredited schools or colleges as electives (or take them during your RNBS program)
- **TOTAL = 120**
