HOW DO YOU ACHIEVE THE 120 CREDITS FOR THE BS IN NURSING?

- 71 ADN credits transferred + 43 credits of EMU nursing courses + 3 credits of history or literature + 3 credits of creative arts + 3 credits of health assessment = 123
