Camp Descriptions

1. **Beginner Violin Camp** is for children ages 3-6 who would like an introduction to playing the violin. For two hours each morning, students will engage in a variety of musical activities in a group setting. This will include a beginning violin class, as well as a song and nature-based Musikgarten class. No instrument needed!
2. **Twinkler Violin Camp** participants will attend camp for two hours each morning, and will participate in violin class activities, as well as a song and nature-based Musikgarten class. This option is appropriate for young students who have already taken a Pre-Twinkle violin class or recently begun violin lessons (Pre-Twinkle through Song of the Wind).
3. **Book 1 Violin & Cello Camp** is for students who are playing in Early Book 1 (Song of the Wind) to Early Book 2. Each morning students will engage with music in a variety of ways, including masterclasses, group activities, and a Music Makers class designed to engage students in a variety of musical concepts. The camp will end with a short group performance on Thursday at 11:40 am. Parents are encouraged to attend!

All camp classes are held at Eastern Mennonite University.
