

Instrumental Lessons Spring 2022

Information & Policies

Eastern Mennonite University preparatory music instructors who are specialists on their particular instrument offer weekly private lessons. Lessons are available to students of every level and age (3years to adult) in the following instruments:

Suzuki method: piano, violin, viola, cello

Other instruments: piano, flute, clarinet, guitar, mandolin, winds, brass, percussion, music theory, violin, viola, cello, and double bass

For the fall, we are offering 15 weeks of lessons.

Instructors

The students and their instructor's schedules determine student placement. Students may choose 30, 45, or 60-minute lessons at the discretion of the instructor. Current instructor listings, studio information, and bios are available at emu.edu/prep-instructors

Suzuki Pre-Twinkle Violin

Classes prepare children with the very basic skills needed to begin violin studies. Classes are designed for students age 3-5. A large emphasis is placed on listening, posture, instrument/bow hold, ear training and focus. These group lessons are held for 14 weeks during the fall. The dates and times are arranged after registration.

Pre-Twinkle (14 Weeks)

\$225 + \$25 program fee

Private Lesson: Fees & Tuition

A deposit of \$180 per student per instrument is due with registration. This includes a \$35 per semester family program fee, which covers all program costs such as administration, office assistance and supplies. The rest of the deposit goes towards the remaining tuition balance. The EMU Business Office will bill you for the remaining tuition balance.

Registration Deadlines

Spring semester:

All applications and deposits must be turned in by January 3, 2022. If you miss the deadline there will be an additional \$15 late fee charged to your account.

Payment Schedule

* Tuition balance payments not received by the due date will receive a finance charge of 1.5% per month (18% APR).

*** If a student starts private lessons and does not complete the full 15 weeks the \$180 deposit and \$35 registration fee will not be refunded.**
