## Red Wing Academy, July 7-10

Red Wing Academy, hosted by Eric Brubaker of The Steel Wheels is a four-day intensive camp held July 7-10, at EMU, leading up to a performance of several tunes on stage with the band at the Red Wing Roots Music Festival on Friday, July 12!

Red Wing Academy is open to non-beginner violin, viola, cello, bass, guitar, mandolin and banjo students ages 5-19. Students will receive individual and group instruction from highly trained music teachers and will also be coached by members of The Steel Wheels. Daily curriculum will include group classes, mini lessons, improv and jam sessions, technique and tone development, stage performance, electives, recreation, panel discussions, showcases, and more.

Scholarship opportunities are available for qualifying students. Admission to the festival and a T-shirt are included for participants. Red Wing Academy Volunteer and Sponsorship opportunities are available in exchange for passes to the Festival.
