2. Roll Call and Check-In

5. Old Business
  - a. A town hall may be needed over Christmas break depending on COVID changes
  - b. SGA will be helping BSA in whatever ways needed for MLK day
6. New Business
  - a. Ultimate Frisbee fund request
    - i. The club is currently in the process of becoming an official club
    - ii. They have requested \$575 for pinnies, disk, and cones to make the most of their space
    - iii. The club wants to get pinnies to look like a uniform team; they currently have been wearing similar colored t-shirts
    - iv. Since they are not a current club, they don't have their own budget
    - v. The pinnies are also reversible
    - vi. Isaac noticed that only 20 pinnies will be ordered, but there are more people that come out then that
    - vii. Matthew said one of the reasons the group picked out those pinnies is because of comfortability and fitting
    - viii. Shannon also added that the pinnies will allow the girls to switch pinnies without actually having to take off any shirt
    - ix. Philip said they tend to switch teams a lot, so having double-sided pinnies is more convenient
    - x. Alyssa added that she thinks it would be cool for the players to have a uniform jersey, to make them feel more like a team
    - xi. Cindi asked how they would choose the sizes for the pinnies
    - xii. Hannah said that was not discussed during the meeting
