The Power of Connection: A Journey to Family Medicine, Teaching, and Quality Improvement Research

Family medicine values the patient narrative and how stories and connections influence health and well-being. Dr. Moyer's presentation will focus on her journey to a career in family medicine, including stories of personal connection and mentorship that impacted her career path and shaped her interests. She will discuss her current role as a faculty member at a family medicine residency program and her quality improvement research focused on advancing interconception and postpartum care through dyadic care models.

Dr. Brianna Moyer is a family medicine physician and faculty member with the Penn Medicine Lancaster General Health Family Medicine Residency Program. She is a proud graduate of Eastern Mennonite University's class of 2011. She attended Penn State Hershey Medical School and completed her family medicine residency at Lancaster General Hospital. She practices full-spectrum family medicine with a particular interest in maternal child health.
