

Sponsor's Affidavit of Severe Economic Hardship and Revised Statement of Annual Cash Support

What This Affidavit Is For:

By completing this affidavit, you are swearing to the U.S. government that you are suffering from unexpected financial difficulties that have affected your previous promise of cash support to the student. You are also revising your statement of annual cash support and proving that you can continue to afford the support you are now promising, *if* any, with the documents you have attached.

Your completion of this form will enable the student to apply for employment authorization in order to help support his or her education in the U.S.

How to Complete This Form:

- Fill out both sides of this form in English or have it translated into English.
- Clearly describe the <u>unexpected</u> circumstances that have caused you to reduce or stop the financial support you previously promised the student. Attach evidence that *proves* the change in your financial situation.
- State the revised amount you will now give to the student and attach the evidence of support explained below which proves your ability to meet t hat financial commitment.
- Sign the affidavit in front of a notary public or the appropriate official in your country.
